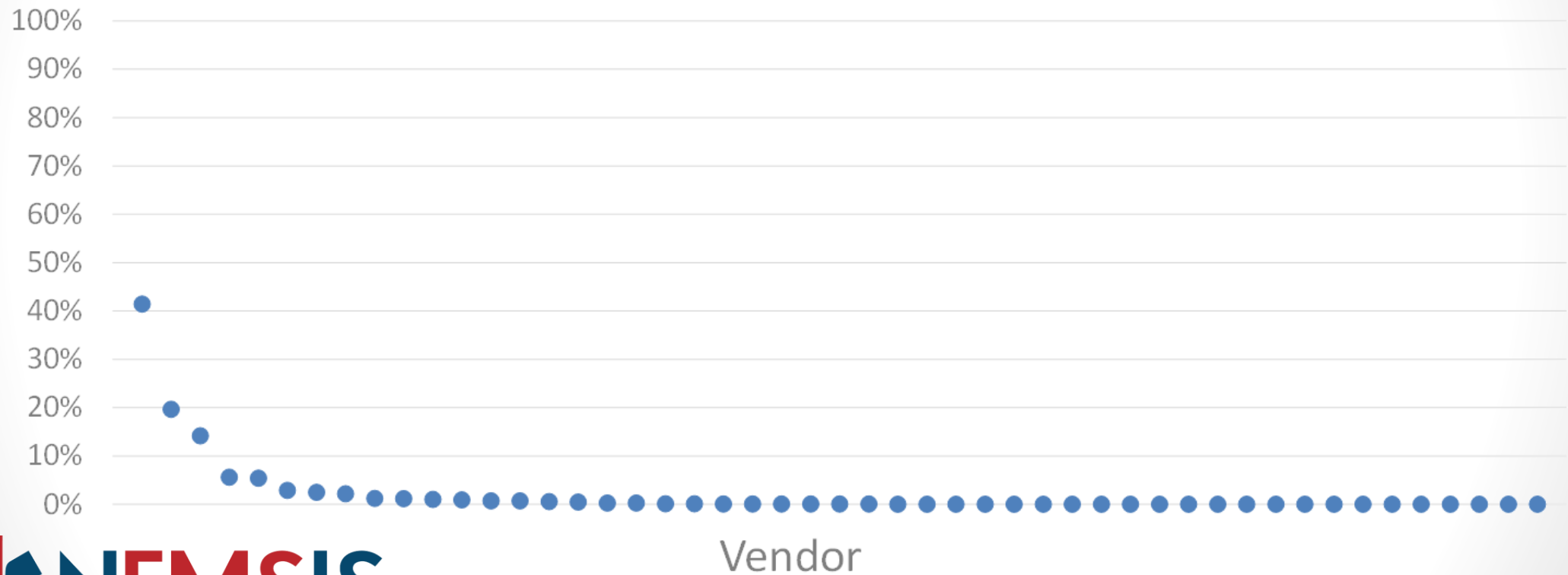

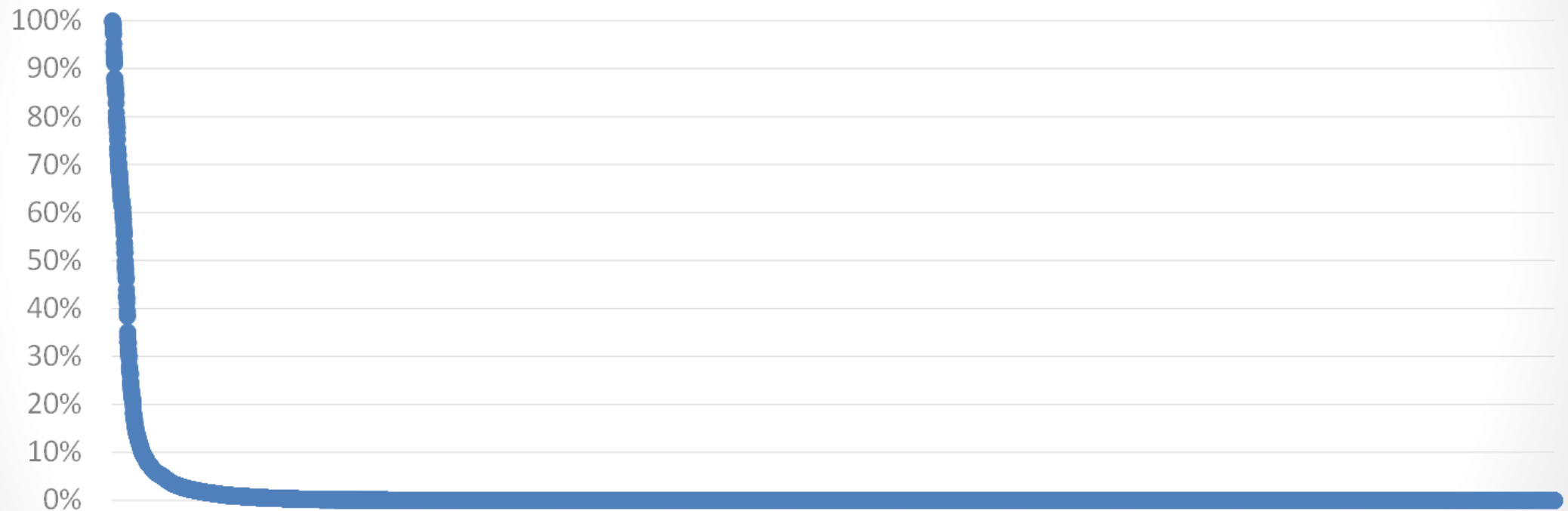

  - Goals: advance specification, prepare for conformance testing events and develop interoperability demonstrations



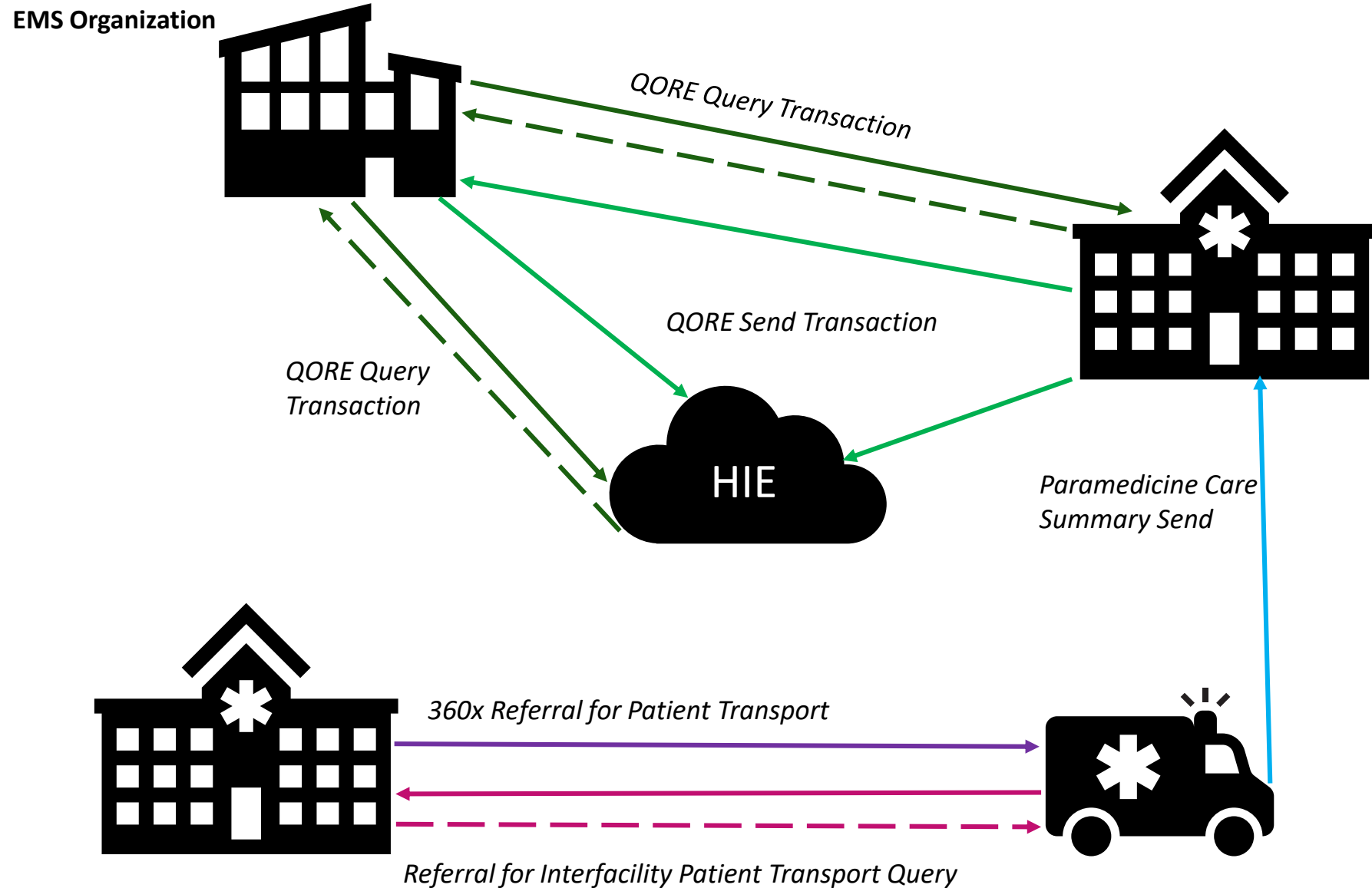
