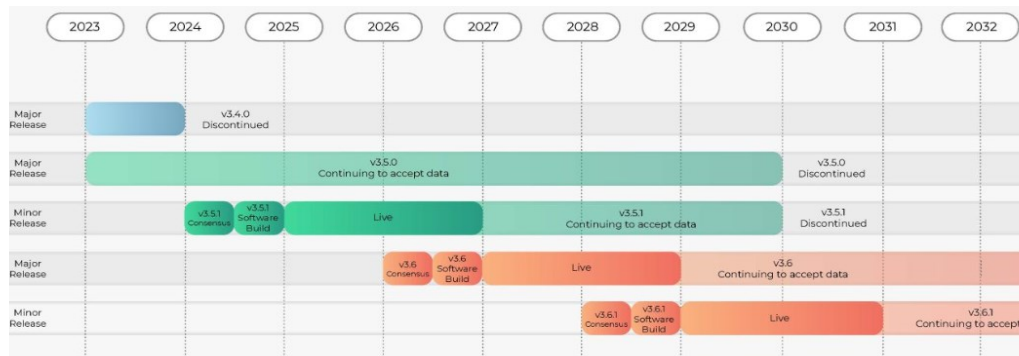
## NEMESIS v3 Versioning Timeline

### The NEMESIS TAC is receiving v3.5 data.

At the request of State Offices of EMS, the sunset date for v3.4 data was extended by 12 months to January 2024.

States are encouraged to implement the v3.5 data standard as soon as they are able. EMS software vendors continue to develop products to support the v3.5 standard.

## Website Changes

### The most recent website changes are:

The American College of Surgeons revised the 2011 Trauma Triage Criteria and established the 2021 National Guidelines for Field Triage of Injured Patients. NEMESIS created a [Infographic with a cross-walk for eInjury.03/eInjury.04 updating to the 2011 criteria.](#)

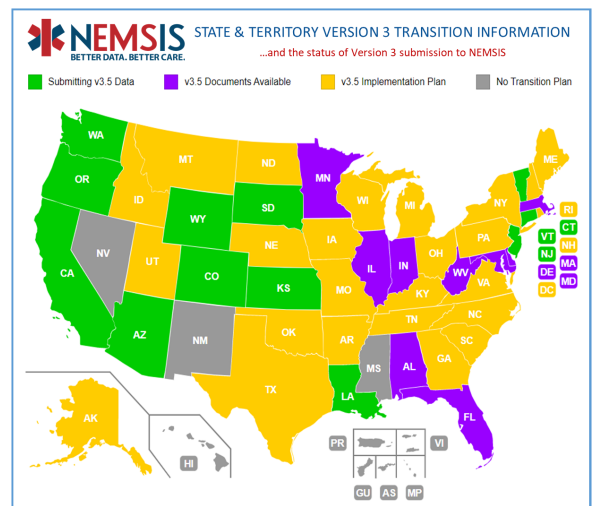
## v3 Data Submission

The NEMESIS TAC collaborates with Vendors and State EMS Data Managers to resolve state-related data quality issues under both the v3.4 and v3.5 data standards. The current national failed submission rate is 0.63%.

## NEMESIS Participation

The NEMESIS state map shows the progression of states and territories as they transition to the version 3.5 data standard. When a state or territory submits version 3.5 resources to the NEMESIS TAC, the state color is updated. We congratulate the twelve states that are submitting v3.5.0 data.

**NEMESIS User Accounts**

The NEMESIS User Accounts policy has been updated to reflect new security standards. The User Accounts are now set to expire after 6 months of inactivity, and users need to reset their passwords every 90 days. States and Vendors are responsible for maintaining who they have authorized for access to their restricted data by notifying the TAC when a User Account needs to be deactivated.
